Meeting Minutes from February 13, 2024

6PM call to order motion made by Nick Mansfield and seconded by Michael Gray

All members were in attendance.

Scott Strahley was present to discuss problems with surveys and markers on the south side of the tracks. He stated that according to his calculations the markers were off approximately 9 ft. Mr. Strahley stated that he would check into markers more thoroughly and get back to council.

Kirk Stoller volunteered to pick up playground equipment if it was coming from Cincinnati.
